

VILLAGE OF STOCKBRIDGE
ORDINANCE NO. 2015.0601, 002
(Enacted June 1, 2015)

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 18,
ARTICLE III, SECTION 18-46 (3) OF THE STOCKBRIDGE VILLAGE CODE,
TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION TO BAN ON THE DISCHARGE OF BOWS
IN INDOOR ARCHERY RANGES

THE VILLAGE OF STOCKBRIDGE ORDAINED:

SECTION 1: Chapter 18, Article III, Section 18-46(3) is Amended to read as follows:

- (3) Discharging of any fireworks, bow and arrow, firearms, air rifle, or sling shot, or the possession of any air rifle or sling shot on any street or any park, unless it is securely wrapped or encased, except a bow and arrow or crossbow and bolt may be discharged in an indoor archery range operating within the Village limits under a valid special use permit granted by the Village;

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Village of Stockbridge declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, clause, or phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, and phrases be declared unconstitutional.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance and the related rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders, and matters established shall take effect immediately upon publication, except any penalty provision which shall take effect twenty (20) days after publication, pursuant to MCL 66.1; MSA 5.1271.

SECTION 4: Repealer - All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed only to the extent necessary to give all provisions of this Ordinance full effect.
